## Knitting Pattern Kp215 Child Baby Owl Jackets Sizes

Wrap your little one in warmth and style with this adorable Baby Owl Jacket. Our pattern Kp215 offers a step-by-step guide to create cozy jackets in various sizes, ensuring a perfect fit for your growing child. With its charming owl appliqués, this jacket will become a cherished wardrobe staple.

- Yarn: DK weight yarn in two contrasting colors
- Knitting needles: 3.25mm (US 3) and 4mm (US 6)
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch markers
- Buttons (optional)

Our pattern provides instructions for the following sizes:

- Newborn (0-3 months)
- 3-6 months
- 6-9 months
- 9-12 months
- 12-18 months
- 22 stitches and 30 rows = 10cm (4 inches) in stocking stitch on 4mm needles

- k: knit
- p: purl
- st(s): stitch(es)
- sl1: slip 1 stitch onto the right-hand needle without knitting
- k2tog: knit the next two stitches together

#### **Front Piece:**



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- With 3.25mm needles and Color A, cast on 80 (86, 92, 100, 108) stitches.
- Row 1: K all stitches.
- Row 2: P all stitches.
- Repeat rows 1 and 2 for 4 rows.
- **Row 5:** K18 (20, 22, 24, 26), place a stitch marker, k to end of row.

- Row 6 and all even rows: Purl to marker, k to end of row.
- **Row 7:** K16 (18, 20, 22, 24), place a stitch marker, k to end of row.
- **Row 9:** K14 (16, 18, 20, 22), place a stitch marker, k to end of row.
- **Row 11:** K12 (14, 16, 18, 20),place a stitch marker, k to end of row.
- **Row 13:** K10 (12, 14, 16, 18),place a stitch marker, k to end of row.
- Continue decreasing in this manner until you have 12 (14, 16, 18, 20) stitches left on the needles.

#### **Back Piece:**

• Follow the same instructions for the front piece.

#### **Sleeves:**

- With 3.25mm needles and Color B, cast on 36 (40, 44, 48, 52) stitches.
- Row 1: K all stitches.
- Row 2: P all stitches.
- Repeat rows 1 and 2 for 4 rows.
- **Row 5:** K3, place a stitch marker, k to end of row.
- Row 6 and all even rows: Purl to marker, k to end of row.
- **Row 7:** K5, place a stitch marker, k to end of row.
- **Row 9:** K7, place a stitch marker, k to end of row.
- **Row 11:** K9, place a stitch marker, k to end of row.

 Continue increasing in this manner until you have 20 (24, 28, 32, 36) stitches on the needles.

#### Assembly:

- Shoulders: Place the right side of the front piece against the wrong side of the back piece, matching the shoulder seams. Sew the seams closed with a mattress stitch.
- Sleeves: Sew the sleeves into the armholes.
- Hood: Create a hood by joining the cast-on edges of the two front pieces. Sew the seam until you have a 10cm (4 inch) wide hood.
- Owl Appliqués: Cut out owl appliqués from felt and sew or glue them onto the front of the jacket.
- Bottom Hem and Cuffs: With 4mm needles and Color A, pick up and knit around the bottom edge of the jacket. Knit 6 (8, 10, 12, 14) rows in stocking stitch.
- Buttonholes: Make 3 (3, 4, 4, 4) buttonholes on the right front piece, evenly spaced. K2, sl1, k2tog, pass slipped stitch over, p to end of row.
- Buttons: Sew 3 (3, 4, 4, 4) buttons to the left front piece, opposite the buttonholes.
- Colors: Choose contrasting colors for the body and sleeves to create a fun and eye-catching look.
- Appliqués: Instead of owl appliqués, use other animal designs or add embroidery for personalization.

- Hood: For a more traditional look, knit a hood separately and sew it onto the neckline.
- Closure: Instead of buttons, use snaps or a zipper for easier fastening.

With its charming owl appliqués and cozy warmth, the Baby Owl Jacket is a perfect addition to your little one's wardrobe. 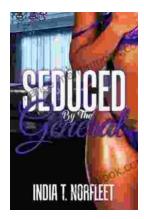


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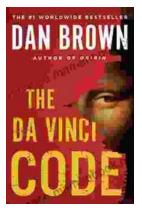
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
